Consumables, office supplies and teacher/art supplies, first aid courses for staff members. "Pocket of poverty" funds go to families that need help with school fees, food and clothing. In trust money can rarely be saved for the next school year so money needs to be spent by June 30th or you risk losing it. Went through the list of all the "mesure" money which is money given by the government grants for very specific uses.
